

2010 Census Golf League Playoffs Format and Rules

The 2010 Census Golf League playoffs will follow a normal 16-team tournament format. The teams are ranked with 1 – 16 with the top team playing the lowest seed and so forth. Total points scored and then average points against playoff teams in your division determined the final seeds.

The rules for the playoffs are as follows:

Playoff Schedule

All matches are to be played the week they are scheduled. The schedule is indicated above each round on the playoff bracket. Enterprise is the default course for playoff matches. However if both teams agree, matches may be played at an alternate course. Please note that Enterprise is not reserved for league play on Wednesday nights. Teams must call to get a tee time for their playoff match. Daylight hours are starting to get short, so please keep this in mind when deciding what time to schedule your match. **IF YOU ARE HAVING TROUBLE GETTING YOUR MATCH SCHEDULED, PLEASE NOTIFY THE LEAGUE CHAIRPERSON (JEFF SISSON) TO RESOLVE SCHEDULING ISSUES.**

Subs During Playoff

Teams can use one sub for a playoff match. The sub pool is expanded to include all current subs and any member of the golf league that is eliminated from the playoffs. As teams are eliminated from the playoffs, they become eligible subs for the later rounds.

Tie Breakers

The tiebreakers for golf league playoff matches will use the tiebreak procedures instituted by the Census Golf Club. The tiebreak procedures can be found at:

Please note that for tiebreaking purposes, teams should determine the results based on three points being awarded per hole (one for each individual match and one for the team match). A tie for any of the three matches would result in a ½ point for each team. The team with the most points over the three tie break holes is the winner of the match. This procedure would continue to the 4th hole if the match is still tied after the first three tiebreak holes.

Please review these tiebreak procedures prior to your first match.
