

On December 5, 2011, the Census Golf Club (CGC) will convert to a new web-based GolfNet system. As of that date, you will no longer be able to use the current web site. If you try to logon to the current system after the conversion, you will be automatically redirected to the new website. We decided to convert after the end of the Maryland 2011 posting season to give us all time to get comfortable with the new system when there is relatively little posting activity.

Golfers who previously established a personal user name and password to post scores online (which should be everyone in the club) will remain unchanged. Golfers who have not previously established a personal user name and password will have their IGN# as a user name and their last name as their password. Contact the CGC administrator at censushdcpadmin@verizon.net if you need to know your IGN#.

The link to the new website is <http://www.msganetwork.org>. If you have any saved bookmarks or favorites pointing to the old web site, make sure you change them to the new.

GolfNet strongly recommends that the computer you use to access the new system have the latest Windows updates from Microsoft. At a minimum, you must have Windows XP with Service Pack 2 installed and Internet Explorer version 8. More current versions of Windows and IE are fine. Other browsers (such as Chrome, Firefox, Safari, etc) are also supported but there may be some minor display issues when using them.
